

Popular Miami-based art blog Whats Up Miami about Elena Bulatova



One of the artists represented by the Miami-based company "Art Marketing Mind" Russian-born Palm Springs-based Elena Bulatova is opening her own gallery space tomorrow April 3rd, 2013 in the hippest art destination in the California desert, the Backstreet Art District, a world renowned art district.

More than a dozen artist-owned galleries and working studios feature eclectic collections of original artwork by international and national artists near the Parker Hotel in east Palm Springs.

With a popular art walk on the first Wednesdays of the month Bulatova, a recipient of the prestigious Fox Fellowship at Yale University, will inaugurate her new space from 6 to 9PM at Highway 111 and Cherokee Way exhibiting 40 of her latest paintings.

Bulatova was one of the first artists to sell pieces during the *Art Marketing Mind*'s first art fair experience during "ArtSpot" at Intrepid Gallery hosted by Red Dot Art Fair on December 2012.

Her decision to open a space in California is mainly because Palm Springs offers a great art community where art is fully appreciated.

"Palm Springs is a beautiful and peaceful place to create art and this district is a haven for local artists to create anything from sculptures to photography to jewelry, paintings and more," said Elena Bulatova, the youngest among all Backstreet artists.

Elena Bulatova's Grand Opening will take place tomorrow April 3rd, 2013 6-9 pm, in Backstreet Art District, 2652 S. Cherokee Way, Palm Springs, Ca, 92264.
